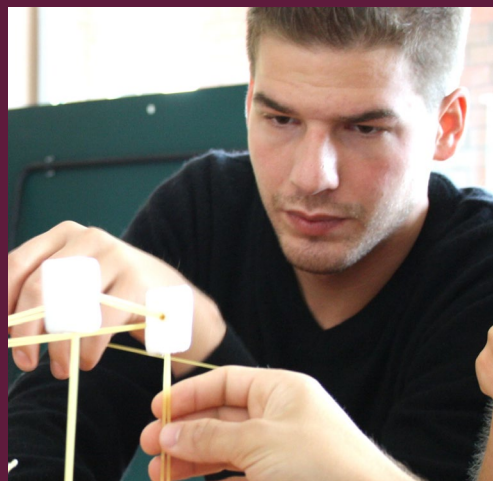
STRATEGIC MANAGEMENT & APPLIED INNOVATION

Undergraduate: July, 2nd to July 6th

In this module you will discover innovation. Analysing different technologies, you will explore the competitiveness of its evolution and diffusion. This includes company visits and meetings with innovative entrepreneurs.



TEG is a collaborative space described as a real «ecosystem dedicated to Entrepreneurship». More than 40 student projects are supported every year within a structure based on education, research and an incubator.



Our Summer School is open to both undergraduate and postgraduate students and has been divided as week-long independent modules each worth 6 ECTS or 3 US credits.

Each module consists of 25 hours contact time and 10 hours of personal and group work.

2 modules are offered for postgraduate students and 4 for undergraduate students.

You may choose as many modules as you like within your education level.

All modules are taught through the Action Learning Pedagogy. Our lecturers are certified from the International Horse&Coaching Method™ and ISIS Creativity Techniques™, as well as from the HPI/D.School™ (Stanford University).
